

PRIVACY POLICY

This policy is the IGT Company LP Privacy Policy for the Website: igt-crypto.io

IGT Company LP protects and respects your privacy.

We would like to inform you about the management of your personal data in accordance with Art. 13 General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

This policy together with Terms of Use of the Web-site and any other documents referred to it sets out the basis on which any personal data we collect from you, or that you provide to us, will be processed by us (further - Personal information, Information, data). Please read the following carefully to understand how the IGT Company LP will treat it. By visiting this web-site you are accepting and consenting to the practices described in this policy.

CONTROLLER

The controller responsible for the described data collection and processing is the IGT Company LP (Office 29, Clifton House, Fitzwilliam Street Lower Dublin 2 Republic of Ireland)

STORAGE OF YOUR IP ADDRESS

We store the IP address transmitted by your web browser for a period of seven (7) days, strictly for the purpose of identifying, restricting and eliminating attacks on our website. After seven (7) days, we delete or anonymize your IP address. The legal basis for the processing of this personal data is provided in the Art. 6 para. 1 point f GDPR.

Types of data, which may be gathered

- information about the visit, including the full Uniform Resource Locators (URL) clickstream to, through and from our site (including date and time); products user viewed or searched for; page response times, download errors, length of visits to certain pages, page interaction information (such as scrolling, clicks, and mouse-overs), and methods used to browse away from the page and any phone number used to call our customer service number.

- technical information, including the internet protocol (IP) address used by the user to connect to the internet, user login information, browser type and version, time zone settings, browser plug-ins types and versions, operating system meta;

- *the IP address of the requesting computer shortened to such an extent that no reidentification of any persona data is possible.*

- Information which the user provides to us includes filling in forms on the website or contacting the Company by phone, e-mail or otherwise. This includes information which the user provides during the registration process, when he or she subscribes to the System, searches for a product, places an order in the System, bails-in tradable amount, uploads files required for identification and financial supervision, enters a competition, promotion or survey, and when reporting a problem to the technical support. The information provided by the user may include users name, address, e-mail address and phone number.

- Information which we receive from other sources. It includes payments and delivery services, advertising networks, analytics providers, search information providers, credit reference agencies.

The listed usage data is stored anonymously.

COOKIES

The site uses cookies to distinguish the user from other users of the site. This helps us to provide users with better experience when browsing the site.

Google Analytics uses “cookies”, which are text files placed on your end device and can be read by us. In this way, we are able to recognize and count returning visitors. This data processing is carried out on the basis of Art. 6 para. 1 s. 1 lit. f GDPR and in the interest of finding out how often our website is viewed by different users.

The information generated by the cookies about your use of the website will be transmitted to and stored by Google on its servers in the United States. We have activated IP-anonymization on this website, your IP address will be truncated within the area of Member States of the European Union. Only in exceptional cases is the whole IP address transferred to a Google server in the USA and truncated there (an adequate level of data protection is ensured according to Art. 45 para. 1 GDPR because Google is a participant in the Privacy Shield Agreement).

You can withdraw your consent to the processing at any time. Please use one of the following options:

You may refuse the use of cookies by selecting the appropriate settings on your browser, however please note that if you proceed accordingly you may not be able to benefit from the full functionality of this website.

You can also prevent Google from collecting the data generated by the cookie and relating to your use of the website (including your IP address) and from processing this data by downloading and installing the browser plug-in available under the link.

USAGE OF THE PERSONAL INFORMATION

- To provide information to users about other goods and services the Company offers, which are similar to those that the user has already purchased or enquired about;
- To carry out obligations arising from any contracts entered by the IGT Company LP and the user, to provide the user with requested information, products and services;
- To provide the users, or permit selected third parties to provide the users with information about goods or services that they may be interested in. If the user is an existing customer, the Company contacts him or her by electronic means (e-mail or SMS) with information about goods and services similar to those which were the subject of a previous sale or negotiations of a sale to the user.
- Notify the user about changes to Company service;

Purposes of Use of the Information

- to keep the site safe and secure;
- to improve the site to ensure that content is presented in the most effective manner for the users and for their computers;

- to administer the site and for internal operations including troubleshooting, data analysis, testing, research, statistical and survey purposes;
- to allow users to participate in interactive features of the site, when the user opts for it;
- to measure the effectiveness of advertising;
- to make suggestions and recommendations.

Information received from other sources

The company may combine information gathered from the third sources with information provided by the user and information collected.

RECIPIENTS OF THE PERSONAL INFORMATION

Personal information may be shared with other recipients, such as:

- Authorities (such as law enforcement authorities, bailiffs, notary offices, tax authorities, supervision authorities and financial intelligence units);
- Auditors, legal and financial consultants, or any other processor authorized by the IGT Company;
- Third parties maintaining registers (such as governmental registers, population registers, commercial registers or other registers holding or intermediating Personal information);
- Debt collectors upon assignment of claims, courts, out-of-court dispute resolution body and bankruptcy or insolvency administrators);
- Rating agencies;
- Other persons who guarantee due discharge of the Client's obligations to the IGT Company (such as sureties, guarantors, owners of collaterals);
- Participants and/or parties related to domestic, European and international payment systems, such as SEPA or SWIFT.
- Other credit institutions, financial institutions, payment card companies, financial services intermediaries;
- Other persons related to provision of services of the IGT Company such as providers of archiving, postal services, providers of services rendered to the Client.

As a general rule the Personal information is processed within the European Union/European Economic Area (EU/EEA) but in some cases transferred and processed to countries outside the EU/EEA.

Transfer and Processing of Personal information outside the EU/EEA can take place if a legal ground is provided, i.e. legal requirement conclusion or performance of an agreement or Client's consent and appropriate safeguards are in place, such as:

- There is an agreement in place including the EU Standard Contractual Clauses or other approved clauses code of conducts, certifications etc., approved in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation;
- The country outside of the EU/EEA where the recipient is located has adequate level of data protection as decided by the EU Commission;
- The recipient is individually certified.

Upon request the Client can receive further details on Personal information transfers to countries outside the EU/EEA.

DATA TRANSFER TO THIRD PARTIES AND STORAGE OF THE PERSONAL INFORMATION

We transfer your data to service providers who support us in the operation of our website and the associated processes. This transference is made under the scope of a data processing agreement in accordance to Art. 28 GDPR. Our service providers are bound to us by strict instructions and contractual obligations. In some cases, we may transfer personal data to third countries outside the EU. In each case, we ensure an appropriate level of data protection according to European standards. In the case of Google Analytics (USA), an appropriate level of data protection is ensured by the corresponding participation in the Privacy Shield Agreement (Art. 45 para. 1 GDPR).

The data that we collect from users may be transferred to, and stored at, a destination outside of the European Economic Area ("EEA"). It may be processed by a staff member operating outside the EEA who work for the Company or its contractors. By submitting your Personal information, you agree to this policy and every its provision. The company takes all the necessary steps to ensure that users data is treated securely and in accordance with this privacy policy.

Any leakage of the information occurred upon transmission of the information, which was caused by any error, third party actions or accident may not be subject of any suites or claims with regard to the Company.

YOUR RIGHTS AS A USER

You have the right to obtain confirmation whether or not personal data concerning you is being processed, and, where that is the case of access to the personal data and the information specified in Art. 15 GDPR.

The right to access abovementioned information may be exercised upon contacting with the company. Any access request may be subject to a fee to cover the costs in extracting and providing the requested data.

You also have the right to obtain an erasure of the personal data concerning you, if one of the reasons listed in Art. 17 GDPR applies. In certain situations, listed in Art. 20 GDPR, you have the right to data portability. If the data is processed pursuant to Art. 6 para. 1 point f GDPR (data processing for the purposes of the legitimate interests), you have the right to object to the processing at any time for reasons arising out of your particular situation. We will then no longer process personal data, unless there are demonstrably compelling legitimate grounds for processing, which override the interests, rights and freedoms of the person concerned, or the processing serves the purpose of asserting, exercising or defending legal claims.

You have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.

CHANGES TO THIS PRIVACY

This policy and any subsequent changes can be made at any time without users' consent and shall be posted on this page and, if required by the laws of Ireland, users shall be notified by e-mail.
